ABOUT THE LIVE STREAM COURSE

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Pediatric urgencies and emergencies can occur in outpatient clinical settings. These cases can pose dilemmas for what treatment should be provided and when a referral should be made. This course will help prepare emergency medicine physicians, pediatricians, family medicine physicians, advanced practice providers, nurses and other outpatient providers who care for children to provide evidence-based and efficient care when these situations arise.

The course schedule has been updated to provide virtual, interactive small-group simulations and an electrocardiography (ECG) workshop, in addition to lectures by world-class speakers. We will be conducting simulation from the Kanbar Center for Simulation and Clinical Skills.

Topics will include COVID-19 and multisystem inflammatory syndrome in children (MIS-C), respiratory infections, mental health emergencies, toxicology, fever, and health care disparities and how they affect outcomes.

OBJECTIVES

The objectives of this course are to understand pediatric emergencies that present in the office or clinic setting. We will discuss treatment guidelines and recommendations for referral.
